- All tests on 20x40m all weather X-Ride surface.
- Warm up on enclosed grass field.
- All Queach Farm Unaffiliated Dressage Competitions are run under British Dressage Rules - see www.britishdressage.co.uk
- Refunds made only on sight of valid vet or doctor's certificate.
- In the event of cancellation by the organisers all entry fees will be refunded.
- Commanders for the NON-CHAMPIONSHIP classes are available at a cost of £1 per test which is donated to the EAST ANGLIAN AIR AMBULANCE.
- Do not leave muck on the car park - a wheel barrow and shovel will be available for you to clear up after your horse.
- Bridle/Saddlecloth numbers must be worn on both sides of the horse and will not be supplied by the venue.
- No Lunging.
- Dogs are welcome, but must be kept on a lead.
